ADVISING NOTES:

*Course taken off-campus: BIOL 227 & Lab

GenEds: Complete all General Education Objective requirements (Obj 1-9)

Major: Complete all ASHS Major Requirements and Competencies (22 credits)

Graduation with Distinction: 3.5+ ISU GPA to be considered for graduation w/academic honors

Credits: Earn a minimum of 60 total credits

Grades: Earn a C- or higher in ENGL 1101 and ENGL 1040 **Grades:** Earn a minimum ISU cumulative GPA of 2.0



Resident Credit: At least 15 credits in the major area of study must be resident credits (credits earned from ISU).

AS Health Science Degree Tips

Create a College Binder or Folder

- student IDs for each college
- account logins for colleges and Advanced Opportunities
- college transcripts
- course syllabi

Check enrollment!

- Check your unofficial transcripts at ISU, NNU, BSU, CWI, and CSI
- Check records after each enrollment and grading period

Do not wait until deadlines to complete tasks





FAQs

□ How will my *credits* transfer?

- Check with the college you plan to attend
- Courses transfer well to in-state public colleges/universities
- Some courses may not transfer as "Direct Course Equivalents" and will show as electives (can petition if you save your course syllabi)

□ How will my *degree* transfer?

- Equivalent to two years of college (could have two or more years left of Bachelor's degree depending on your major)
- The AS degree = "core-certified" (General Education courses done)





FAQs Cont'd...

□ What's a transcript?

- *High School* vs. *College* transcript?
- When I apply to college, will I apply as a transfer or <u>new</u> <u>freshman</u>?
- □ When will I get my ISU diploma with my AS degree?
 - After high school graduation:
 - Degree Awarded (Late June)
 - Diploma Sent (July)





FAQs Cont'd...

□ Will Fast Forward pay for the whole degree?

- 60 total credits required for the ASHS degree
- Cost is \$75/credit total *min* cost is \$75 x 60 credits = \$4,500
- Cost Savings Two years of college tuition at Idaho public university approx. \$16,000
- Additional opportunities to use AO funding exists outside of the ASHS program. This may require out-of-pocket expenses that is the responsibility of the family.
